\*The Los Angeles Department of Mental Health (DMH) aims to expand opportunities for community-based projects to decrease stigma and increase access to care in diverse communities. As of the past five months, we would like to remind interested, qualified, registered Los Angeles County Underserved Cultural Communities (UsCC) capacity-building projects will be posted in an open process through the Internal Services Department (ISD). These projects are for under \$100,000 and completed by June 30, 2025. **Each project will have a specific title, Statement of Work, requirements complete and upload, and a firm deadline to submit online.** *There will be over 20 projects, ISD manages the entire solicitation process, and DMH staff are unable to respond to questions about the projects.*
